



Q. Answer the following questions

1. How is soil formed?

Ans:- Soil is formed when rocks break up into pieces

2. How will you show that soil contains air?

Ans: Take some soil in a bowl. Pour some water over the soil.

We will see bubbles of air coming out of the soil. This is because the air present in the spaces between the soil particles escapes in the form of bubbles.

3. Why can most plants not grow well in: i) clayey soil

ii) Sandy soil?

Ans(i): The soil particles in clayey soil do not have large spaces between them. There is not much air in the soil. Water cannot go through the soil easily. The soil therefore holds a lot of water and is sticky. Plant roots need both air and water. Therefore, most plants cannot grow well in clayey soil.

Ans⁽ⁱⁱ⁾:- The soil particles in sandy soil has large particles with lots of spaces between them. Water goes through these spaces very easily. Therefore sandy soil cannot hold much water and very few plants can grow in sandy soil.
