Q1:-> What is a globe?

Ans:-> A globe is a small model of the earth.

Q2:-> What are longitudes?

Ans:-> The lines running from the north pole to the South pole on the globe are called longitudes.

Ans:-> A network of lines running horizontally on the globe are called latitudes.

Q4:-> What is the Prime Meridian?

Ans:-> The line of longitude which passes through Greenwich near London in UK is numbered 0° . This line of longitude is called the Prime Meridian.

Q6:-> What is a grid on a map?

Ans:-> The latitudes and longitudes at any place cross each other at a right angle. They form a sort of a net on a map. This is called a grid.
